Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also required us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	 The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social security number and income Account balance and payment history Credit history and credit scores When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

Why can't I limit all sharing?	 affiliates, or other companies. Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State Laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Such as: • Community Development Bank, Ogema, MN
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Grow SD, NESDCAP, and NESDEC do not share with non-affiliates.
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Grow SD, NESDCAP, and NESDEC do not jointly market.
